Dear families

Welcome to the end of another great week at Fairhouse. The rain did not stop the fun we had today. Today we all came together to celebrate and support Children in Need and to promote one of our most important core values: kindness. This week we have been promoting this value and celebrating acts of kindness. We kept a tally chart to record acts of kindness seen in each class. Our celebration assembly this week was focussed around pupils who go above and beyond to demonstrate kindness. The children also spent time building friendships with another class this afternoon, sharing in kindness activities. It has been a pleasure to see the children share and recognise kindness in themselves and others.

It was lovely to see so many of you come along to our parents' evenings this week. I hope you found the time useful. We received a HUGE response from our surveys – thank you for taking the time to give us the feedback. I will be working on collating all this information over the next few weeks and will report back the summary data once this is all done. At first glance, it looks very positive and the comments have been wonderful to read.

It was also lovely to see our year 1 parents come along to our phonics and reading workshop yesterday. We hope you found the session useful in understanding how we use phonics to help teach reading and that you understood more about the phonics screening check all pupils take at the end of year 1.

On Thursday this week, our school held the annual Berlesduna Academy Trust's maths competition. Four of our most confident mathematicians from year 3 and 4 were selected to represent Fairhouse Primary School. They worked hard as a team, using a range mathematical skills to answer seven rounds of questions. The scores were incredibly close. We came a very respectable 5th place out of 11 schools. What a great morning we had! Well done Sharav, Samia, Ozaze and Abel. And a huge thank you to Ms Tansey for organising this event.

This week, year 4 had their first visit to Mundy House as part of their Archie Project. All pupils thoroughly enjoyed their time with the residents and cannot wait to go back in the new year.

In Year 1 this week, we started our funny faces unit in art. We had to create a collage of different facial features and see how funny we could make the face.

Children chose cartoon mouths, different coloured eyes, silly hats and more for their faces! Both classes decorated poppies and created a wreath for Remembrance Day.









Also this week, our children joined in with a minute's silence for Remembrance. The children demonstrated maturity and understanding. Key stage 2 and year 2 children also joined in with an assembly held by an external visitor who explained the background of Remembrance and the importance of marking this event.

Today we say thank you and goodbye to Miss Prior who leaves us to take up a different position within our Trust. We wish her every success in her new role.

<u>Important information - Term time holidays</u>

Improving school attendance is a key priority for all schools across Essex. Where families choose to take a family holiday during term time, this can detrimentally impact a pupil's progress and can prevent them from fulfilling their true academic potential. Our school attendance policy, available via our school website, clearly sets out the process that parents should follow if they wish to apply for leave during term time. Please note that applications should only be made, if you feel that there are exceptional circumstances which mean that the leave cannot be taken during the school holidays. We would ask all parents to note that, where families choose to go on holiday during term time and the absences are coded as unauthorised, Essex County Council may not issue penalty notices and may instead proceed straight to prosecution and place the case directly before the Magistrates for their consideration in court. If found quilty by the Magistrates, parents could face a fine of up to £2,500 and/or 3 months imprisonment.

- Black school shoes or ALL BLACK trainers (including black soles no big logos or brand names).








Shout Outs
