Dear families

Welcome to the end of another very busy week at Fairhouse.

Today, we had our Christmas jumper day and Christmas dinner. The children had a great time, tucking into their festive food, enjoying Christmas music and pulling crackers. We also held a lucky plate competition today with one child from each year group winning a selection box. A HUGE thank you to our wonderful catering team for putting this on for everyone and to all our staff who helped out with making our Christmas dinner a huge success.

This week, we have continued our festive Christmas assemblies. The children all did an amazing job of entertaining their audiences with their wonderful singing, poetry sharing and information giving. A big thank you to all of you who came along to support. On Tuesday next week, we have year 5's assembly and we finish with year 4 on Wednesday.

On Thursday, our school choir visited the Eastgate Shopping Centre to sing some Christmas carols and raise funds for St Luke's Hospice. The children all did a fantastic job showcasing their singing voices. They even gave the audience a sneak peak of the Wicked medley that they will be performing at the O2 in February! Thank you to all the parents and carers who came along to watch and cheer them on.

We will be holding our Christmas disco after school on Wednesday 17th December. The EYFS and key stage 1 Christmas party will be 4.00pm - 5.30pm. Please drop children round to their classrooms / normal collection points and collect from the same place at the end of the disco. The key stage 2 disco will be 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm. Please drop children to the side entrance of KS2. Children will be collected from the side playground for key stage 2. Please make sure children are collected promptly. Both events cost £5 per child and will be cash on the door on the night. All children will be given a bowl of chips, a drink and a glow stick. For key stage 2 children, they will have the option to purchase sweets and extra glow sticks during the disco. Please note, we will not allow children to attend the disco if they have not been at school that day.

We are very much looking forward to Monday's pantomime. We have a visiting pantomime for all children in EYFS, year 1 and year 2. The cost of this has been paid for by our school event fundraising money. All children in key stage 2 have the chance to visit the Towngate Theatre at a cost which has been heavily subsided also using our school event fundraising money. Please remember that key stage 2 children will not be back to school for collection until 4.15 pm.

In other news.....This week, Year 6 have been diving into the world of abstract art. Pupils explored the work of key abstract trailblazers, studying how each artist used colour, shape and technique to express ideas and emotions. After researching different styles and creative approaches, the children experimented with these methods to inspire their own abstract pieces. Linking their art to our history topic Maafa, they produced thoughtful, expressive works that reflect their understanding of this important unit.

In Year 1, during Maths, we have been working on partitioning numbers between 0 and 10 into two parts and three parts. In Geography, we completed a Now Press Play activity to help us secure our knowledge on the four countries in the United Kingdom. We had to help King Charles to escape the evil Dr Disguise! We also have been learning about the seven continents and the equator - you may have heard us singing a song about this. During our Creative Curriculum Day, we focussed on Art. We used cutting, sticking and joining skills to create a collage self-portrait. We even learned how to do a running stitch.

Breakfast Club

<u>Important information - Term time holidays</u>

Improving school attendance is a key priority for all schools across Essex. Where families choose to take a family holiday during term time, this can detrimentally impact a pupil's progress and can prevent them from fulfilling their true academic potential. Our school attendance policy, available via our school website, clearly sets out the process that parents should follow if they wish to apply for leave during term time. Please note that applications should only be made, if you feel that there are exceptional circumstances which mean that the leave cannot be taken during the school holidays. We would ask all parents to note that, where families choose to go on holiday during term time and the absences are coded as unauthorised, Essex County Council may not issue penalty notices and may instead proceed straight to prosecution and place the case directly before the Magistrates for their consideration in court. If found quilty by the Magistrates, parents could face a fine of up to £2,500 and/or 3 months imprisonment.
